What is CSA?

CSA stands for “Community Supported Agriculture.” It’s a simple arrangement where you purchase a “share” of produce from a farm. In return, farm shares receive seasonal, organically grown produce. **You will receive the freshest, most nutritious food available, grown without synthetic pesticides or fertilizers.** In addition, you are preserving working farmland, supporting sustainable agriculture, reducing trucking and packaging costs, and keeping farmers on the land. CSA works for you, local agriculture, and the environment!

General Share Information

CSA shares are distributed for about 24 weeks, late May through mid November. Sharers purchase a Harvest debit card, one per family. You can come to the farm on any of our three pickup days, choose the produce you want, and check out using your debit card. You can also use your card at the New Milford Farmers Market. During the season, you will receive a weekly newsletter with recipes, farm news, and information on how to use and store your produce.

Fort Hill Farm CSA Shares

Flexible pick up days allow you to fit a visit to the farm into your schedule. Shareholders can choose their share from harvested and displayed crops on Tuesday and Thursday from 2:00 PM to 6:30 PM, and Saturday 8AM to 12:30PM. Our CSA share allows you to tailor your share to your family’s tastes by choosing what you want and debiting your Harvest card. Some crops, such as herbs, beans, cut flowers and strawberries, are also available as pick-your-own. Pick-your-own crops are also debited from your card.

What we grow:

Early season crops include: spinach, lettuce, arugula, radishes, salad turnips, scallions, Chinese cabbage, kale, bok choy, broccoli, broccoli raab, sugar snap peas, fennel, Swiss chard, cabbage, bunched beets, salad greens, and strawberries*.

Mid season crops include: garlic, tomatoes, cherry tomatoes, sweet corn, salad greens, zucchini, yellow squash, cucumbers, carrots, big sweet onions, green and wax beans*, potatoes, watermelon, cantaloupe, garlic scapes, flowers*, and herbs*

Late season crops include: salad greens, lettuce, arugula, tomatoes, cherry tomatoes, garlic, carrots, beets, leeks, red and green peppers, hot peppers, eggplant, broccoli, kale, collards, spinach, parsnips, celery, sweet potatoes, Brussels sprouts, winter squash, and rutabagas.

*indicates Pick Your Own. The PYO patch is open 30 minutes before and after each distribution.

How we grow: Fort Hill Farm produce is ***certified organic*** by Baystate Organic Certifiers. We also sign the CT Northeast Organic Farming Association “Farmers Pledge”, and we are a Real Organic Project member farm. Our growing systems are based on time-honored, ecologically sound agricultural principles that build healthy soils. All our produce is grown on the farm.
